In order to ensure that every deserving Rotarian's contributions are considered, DG Cindi O'Neil would like your help in identifying potential nominees for several awards. **Nominations must be presented to Awards Committee Chair District Treasurer (DT) Jim Polk or District Secretary (DS) Beth Sheehan by April 30, 2021.** The nominations can be made by identifying the nominee with an accompanying explanation, with examples, of why the candidate is a worthy recipient of the award. The awards which may be presented include the following:

The Presidential Rotary Citation (RI Recognition) – Clubs may qualify for this RI distinction by following the criteria set forth at Pre-PETS 2020 and established by RI President Holger Knaack. Avenues of Service Award (RI Recognition) - Districts can nominate a member who has performed service in all five Avenues of Service for an award from Rotary International. **A Club President needs to submit** the name and supporting documentation to the Governor for submission to RI. Avenues of Service Award (District recognition) - With an award from their District, clubs can honor a Rotarian who participates in service activities in one of the five Avenues of Service — club, vocational, community, international, and youth service. Nomination by Club or member.

D5110 Rotarian of the Year Award (District Recognition) – Club Presidents can nominate Rotary members who have demonstrated outstanding Rotary service globally or locally, demonstrates Rotary's Core Values, works to involve multiple Clubs and community partners, and whose exemplary leadership has distinguished them as an esteemed volunteer worthy of emulation. Nomination by Club President. Decision by District Governor.

Outstanding Rotarian in Community Service (District Recognition) – This award recognizes a 5110 Rotarian who has provided exemplary dedication and effort in a Community Service Project. Nominations by Clubs or Members.

Outstanding Rotarian in Public Image (District Recognition)– This award recognized a 5110 Rotarian who has provided exemplary dedication and effort in expanding the public image of Rotary and District 5110. Nomination by Clubs or Members.

Outstanding District Leader (District Recognition) - This award recognizes a 5110 Rotarian who serves in a district leadership position whose exemplary leadership and dedication has distinguished them as an esteemed leader worthy of emulation. Nomination by Clubs or Members.

Club Innovation Award (District Recognition) – Clubs can self-nominate for innovations by Members that overcame the significant obstacles of the COVID 19 pandemic in order to continue the vital role of Rotary for their members, their community and the world. Nomination by Club or Members.

The award will not be given solely in recognition of one's performance in an elected or appointed Rotary assignment. Personal financial contributions to Rotary, its Foundation, or any individual project are not relevant considerations for this award.

Service Award for a Polio-Free World - Honors Rotarians who have made outstanding contributions to our polio eradication efforts.

Rotary Award for Excellence in Service to Humanity - Recognizes non-Rotarians, including partners and spouses of Rotarians, who have demonstrated exemplary humanitarian service in accord with Rotary's ideals.
