

# CALL FOR DISTRICT GRANT APPLICATIONS

## DUE JUNE 1<sup>st</sup> for 2024-25 Rotary year



District grants are a great way to leverage your club's funds to do more impactful projects in your community and overseas. This coming Rotary year, the District will match club funds 1:1 up to \$2000, yielding a project value of \$4000. Don't leave "money on the table" by missing this opportunity to participate in district grants.

District grants can be used for:

- a. Humanitarian projects
- b. Scholarships
- c. Interact club support
- d. Rotaract club support
- e. Vocational training teams
- f. RYLA campers
- g. Rotary Youth Exchange
- h. Related-grant travel

If you haven't already, canvas your community or your past partners to determine an appropriate project(s). Clubs can submit 2 grant applications each year, 1 high and 1 medium priority.

### GRANT RESOURCES

The Grant committee has posted all the resources clubs need to qualify, manage, and report on district grants. On DACdb, click on the district tab at the top, the district grant icon, change org year to 24-25, and see links on landing page.

### CLUB QUALIFICATION CHECKLIST

To participate in district grants and receive grant funds, clubs must qualify each year.

Your club must complete the following:

- President and PE sign MOU
- Treasurer initials MOU
- Pay district and RI July dues invoices
- Be current on district grant reports
- Grant writer attend or view April 13<sup>th</sup> training
- President project year and Treasurer attend Grant Stewardship training on June 15<sup>th</sup>
